## 30th Anniversary Block Party FAQ's

## PLEASE DON'T FORGET TO PICK UP YOUR WRISTBANDS BEFORE THE EVENT

- Q: When and where is this event?
- A: The Anniversary Party is September 22<sup>nd</sup> from 10:00 to 7:00 pm. The celebration will encompass the Lagoon, Park and along Regatta (from Mariner to the clubhouse). There are 3 entrances: Lagoon Park, Regatta NW & Regatta SE.
- Q: How do we get into the event?
- A: Everyone attending must be wearing a special DSCA wristband to gain entrance into the event.
- Q: Where do we pick up the wristbands and what is the cost?
- A: The wristbands are available at the DSCA office. You must have your Desert Shores ID card to pick up your wristbands. Wristbands are free to anyone who has a Desert Shores ID card and their registered family members living in Desert Shores. Guest wristbands are available to purchase prior the event for \$10 each and there is no limit to the number of guests that can attend. Children 3 and under are free and are not required to have a wristband. Once you have the wristband, you can enter, exit and reenter for the entire event.
- Q: How can we pay for extra wristbands?
- A: Check, Money order, debit, or credit only.
- Q: I am a renter, can I attend the event?
- A: If the owner of the home has completed the "Assignment of Privileges" form prior to the event and the renter has their Desert Shores ID Card then wristbands are available for you at the DSCA office.
- Q: I am an owner but I have assigned my privileges over to my tenant, can I still attend the event?
- A: The deeded owner will be able to pick up one (1) free wristband or purchase as many wristbands as desired.
- Q: Are we able to bring food or drinks in to the event?
- A: There is no outside food or drink allowed along the street area. Food and drink are allowed in the lagoon area only. No glass is permitted.
- Q: Is this a family friendly/pet friendly event?
- A: The celebration is open to all ages and the Lagoon Park will serve as a gated Kid Zone filled with games and bounce houses. This event will only be open for service animals that have been properly registered with the DSCA office and must be properly leashed and in the owners control at all time.
- Q: Where is vehicle parking or how do I get to the event?
- A: There is no parking available in the Lagoon parking lot but will be open for drop off/pick up only. Parking will be limited to street parking where allowed throughout the community. Tip: Metro will be patrolling and ticketing vehicles parked in "red" zones. There will be a courtesy shuttle driving the main loop around the community and picking up/dropping off at designated bus stops. These designated bus stops will be properly marked at the following locations and will stop in this order: Lagoon Park (NW Event Entrance), South Lake Maddison, North Lake Maddison, North Lake Jacqueline, North Lake Lindsey, Regatta & Mariner (SE Event Entrance), South Lake Lindsey and end at the Lagoon Park (West Event Entrance). The shuttle will circulate and stop at each bus stop every 15 minutes. Parking at the Lakeside Center is restricted to customers only and will be monitored.
- Q: Can we enjoy the Lagoon without attending the celebration?
- A: Yes but you will still be required to have a wristband to enter the Lagoon Park on that day.
- Q: Will there be food and beverages available?
- A: Yes, there will be several food trucks offering burgers, hot dogs, sandwiches, Mexican, Italian, snow cones, coffee, beer, wine, frozen margaritas and much much more. All food and beverage is available for purchase. Alcohol sales will require proof of age and a separate wristband. There will be a covered tent with tables & chairs to enjoy a meal and listen to the music.
- Q: Where is the live entertainment and fireworks show?
- A: The stage will be located on Regatta Dr. near where Lake Jacqueline and the Lagoon Park meet, facing toward the lake and park. The fireworks show will be launched off of South Lake Jacqueline with the best seats being on the grass area between the Lagoon Park and Mariner Dr. Feel free to bring blankets and chairs to enjoy the music and fireworks.
